Reserving a Wedding Date

Weddings are customarily held on Saturdays and not on holidays. To reserve a wedding date at Limestone Presbyterian Church or to have a Limestone pastor officiate at another location, please contact our Church Office at 302.994.5646 or by Email at: XXXXX Someone will advise you on the availability of your desired date and work with you in contacting our pastors. Please note that your wedding will not be finally confirmed on our calendar until you meet with a pastor. In the event you wish to have someone other than our pastor perform the ceremony, you must receive approval from our pastor in advance.

We welcome those who are not church members to hold their wedding at Limestone Presbyterian Church. Members of Limestone Presbyterian Church are given priority for dates and times.

Premarital Counseling

The pastor will require a couple to meet with them for several times before the wedding for pre-marriage counseling. According to the governance of the Presbyterian Church (USA), the minister is responsible to bless and approve each wedding he/she officiates; therefore, **you must meet with your minister before your wedding date can be confirmed.** Our pastors use a variety of resources with couples to help them build a good foundation for a joyful, caring marriage for the years to come.

In the event that the pastor asks the couple to meet with an outside premarital counselor in lieu of meeting with the pastor, the couple is responsible for the charges.

Marriage License From The State Of Delaware

A marriage license from the State of Delaware is required to marry at Limestone Presbyterian Church. Please give the wedding coordinator your Delaware marriage license no later than the
